We request a donation of 20% of your evening’s proceeds and one item from your stock to raffle to help cover the costs of the event. **This year we are also requesting a \$25.00 registration fee submitted on a voluntary basis as we did last year. (See more explanation on the reverse side).** Spaces are 10’ x 10’ each. You will be responsible for providing a table(s) and any supplies needed to set up your booth. Vendor spaces are outside the Community Center. Please bring your own shade.

Set-up will begin at 12:00 noon. Please no early birds. The crowd and the Parade will arrive at 3:00 p.m. The Celebration will end at 6:00 p.m.

Vendor applications must be mailed; e-mail applications will not be accepted.
